Trenton, Nebraska February 5th, 2018

A meeting of the County Board of Commissioners of Hitchcock County, Nebraska was held at the Hitchcock County Courthouse Commissioner's Room, 229 East D Street, Trenton, Nebraska on Monday, the 5th, day of February, 2018 commencing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. Present were Chair Scott McDonald, Commissioners Paul Nichols and Ron Wertz, and County Clerk Margaret Pollmann. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Hitchcock County News, the designated method for giving notice. Board agendas are posted on the County's website www.hitchcockcounty.ne.gov. Notice of the meeting was given to the Chair and all members of the Board. All proceedings hereafter shown where taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. The Open Meetings Act was available for review and Chair indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

Chair McDonald called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Tyler Thiessen, Hitch and Hay Public Transit presented a Letter of Intent regarding local match sources. Attorney Garner advised as to the same and discussion was held.

Member Wertz moved to direct chair to sign letter signifying the County's intent for financial support of Hitch and Hay Public Transit. Member McDonald seconded the motion and after consideration the following members voted in favor of the motion: McDonald, Wertz and Nichols. Motion carried.

Tyson Bardsley and Brian Langenberg with Miller and Associates Consulting Engineers met with the board regarding the County Surveyor position.

Mark Rouse joined the meeting and advised as to the Replat of Riverside Subdivision located in Part of the NW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 13, Township 3 North, Range 32 West of the 6th P.M., Hitchcock County, Nebraska. Attorney Garner advised as to the process for replatting a subdivision.

Member Wertz moved to approve the replat of the Riverside Subdivision as presented. Member Nichols seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: Nichols, Wertz and McDonald. Motion carried. The official replat document was executed by Chair McDonald and Clerk Pollmann.

Chair executed the Subgrant Amendment for Child Support Enforcement Services.

Board acknowledged receipt of claim of Brian K. Buhr filed under the Nebraska Political Subdivision Tort Claim Act. Said claim has been forwarded to the County's insurance carrier.

Road department inventories were reviewed for the purpose of surplusing certain equipment. A surplus property affidavit will be prepared for consideration at the February 20th, 2018 meeting.

Sheriff Bryan Leggott joined the meeting. Sheriff pickup bids were opened as published at 11:00 a.m. Three bids were received, Tom Dinsdale, Hastings, NE (\$27,869.00), Janssen Chrysler, North Platte, NE (\$29,853.00) and Gregg Young Chrysler, Grand Island, NE (\$27,500.00). Each bid was publicly opened and read by Chair McDonald. Bids were reviewed and compared.

Dennis Maggart with McInnes Group joined the meeting and presented information as to the March 1st health and dental insurance renewal. Extensive discussion on renewal options and Mid American Benefits deductible funding.

Member McDonald moved to accept the bid of Greg Young CDJR for a 2018 Dodge Ram 4x4 pickup in the amount of \$27,500.00. Member Nichols seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: Wertz, McDonald and Nichols. Motion carried.





Treasurer was in receipt of \$50.00 from Board of Education Lands & Funds for room rent and \$81.39 from Central Crude for oil production, both credited to the General Fund; \$1.00 from Vonage American and \$6.00 from Centurytel Inc. for 911 surcharges, both credited to the 911 Emergency Services Fund; \$45,060.23 from the State of NE DOT for County Bridge Match reimbursement, credited to the Road Fund (Street Buyback Program).

Member Nichols moved to adjourn at 12:20 p.m. and to meet for the next regular meeting on Tuesday, February 20^{th,} 2018 at 9:00 a.m. Member Wertz seconded the motion and the roll was called with the following members voting in favor of said motion: McDonald, Wertz, and Nichols. Motion carried.
