A meeting of the Hitchcock County Board of Equalization of Hitchcock County, Nebraska was held at the Hitchcock County Courthouse, 229 East D Street, Trenton, Nebraska on the 3rd day of October, 2016 as published. Present were Chair Scott McDonald, Commissioners Ron Wertz and Paul Nichols, County Clerk Margaret Pollmann, County Assessor Marlene Bedore and County Attorney D. Eugene Garner. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Hitchcock County News. Board agendas are posted on the County's website www.hitchcockcounty.ne.gov. Notice of the meeting and availability of the agenda were given to the Chair and all members of the Board. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. The Meetings Act was available for review and Chair indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

Member McDonald moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following items: 1. Approval of the October 3rd, 2016 agenda; 2. Approval of the September 6th, 2016 meeting minutes. Member Nichols seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of said motion. Wertz, Nichols, and McDonald. Motion carried.

Assessor Bedore gave her monthly report: CAMA Export to Revenue, Homesteads, Levys, Inspections in Palisade and Stratton, recent farmland auction, grain bin valuations, and property tax credits.
